## **Professional Development Fellowship**

### **Program Description**

NDOA Professional Development Fellows are awarded a cash scholarship to attend the non-profit leadership program of their choice. They must be currently enrolled in an accredited school (which include, but are not limited to, Seattle University, University of Washington Evans School/Certificate programs, etc.). NDOA will not award Professional Development Fellowships for one-time seminars, conferences, or workshops.

### **Application Deadline**

Applications are due **June 1, 2010**

### **Amount of Award**

Up to \$3,000

### **Renewable**

Former recipients may apply for ONE additional year of support

### **Fellowship Benefits**

- Cash award up to \$3,000.
- Free dues for ONE membership in the Northwest Development Officers Association for one full NDOA membership year (\$110) July 1<sup>st</sup> – June 30<sup>th</sup>.
- Reduced fee to the NDOA's winter and spring training conferences.
- Free admission to NDOA trainings and seminars for one full fiscal year.

- ALL applicants are required to submit a full application.
- ALL recipients must submit a year-end summary of the educational year.
